# Bridging to Juniors

This is what the average troop does as far as who pays for what. You can choose to do as you wish. Since you are bridging soon, I highly suggest you encourage your parent to renew for next Girl Scout year before you have your bridging.

**UNIFORMS**: Usually parent pays, but the troop decides on which sash or vest.

**VEST SIZING:** Junior vests are not cut the same as Brownie vests. With the sizing below, you do not need to size up for growth or to fit over a jacket. We have done that work for you. This vest is worn for 4th and 5th grade.

Medium fits a girl currently wearing a size 5-6 shirt
Large fits a girl currently wearing a size 7-8 shirt
X-Large fits a girl currently wearing a size 10-12-14
2X fits a girl currently wearing a size 16 or larger
Plus sizes available for in-between sizing
